**Mayer Brown Prize in Ethics and Jurisprudence**

**Regulations**

Mayer Brown (the “Donor”) will donate a prize to the Faculty of Law of The Chinese University of Hong Kong on an annual basis starting from the academic year 2018-2019. Regulations governing the award of the prize are detailed below:

1. The prize will be known as “Mayer Brown Prize in Ethics and Jurisprudence”.
2. The amount of the prize is HK\$5,000.
3. The prize shall be awarded to a full-time or part-time student in the postgraduate course *Ethics and Jurisprudence* offered by the Faculty of Law on the basis of academic merit.
4. The recipient of the prize needs not be a Hong Kong permanent resident.
5. Each year, the Dean of the Faculty of Law will be invited to nominate one suitable candidate for the prize, and the particulars of the prize recipient will be sent to the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid for onward transmission to the Donor for information.
6. In any year if no candidate is considered to have reached a standard worthy of the prize, no prize shall be made. The Donor’s decision in respect of the award of the prize will be final.
7. The Donor shall give the University twelve months notice if the prize is to cease.
