Regulations

In 2014, in remembrance of the late Ms Betty Ho, Gallant Ho Charities & Public Well-Being Services (H.K., P.R.C.) Ltd. (“the Donor”) has established ten prizes to be awarded to students of the Faculty of Law, The Chinese University of Hong Kong for an initial period of five years (from 2014-2015 until 2018-2019). The regulations governing the award of the prizes are detailed below:

1. Name of Prizes

The prizes will be known as ‘Betty Ho Prize in Law’ 何美歡法學成績優異獎; ‘Gallant Ho Prize in Law’ 何耀棣法學成績優異獎; and ‘Gallant Ho Gold Prize in Law’ 何耀棣法學成績卓越金獎.

2. Betty Ho Prizes in Law

Six prizes of HK\$10,000 each will be awarded to students from the following years of study who, as determined by the Faculty of Law Undergraduate Assessment Panel (for LLB students) and the Postgraduate Assessment Panel (for JD students) have achieved the best performance in terms of the overall Grade Point Average in the current academic year:-

- LLB Year 1
- LLB Year 2
- LLB Year 3
- LLB Year 4
- JD Year 1
- JD Year 2

One prize of \$10,000, the “Betty Ho Prize in Law for Summer Study Abroad” will be awarded to the best Year 2 or Year 3 LLB student in terms of the overall Grade Point Average who has not been selected as recipient of the Betty Ho Prize in Law and who take part in a Summer Study Abroad Programme administered by the Faculty of Law during the summer immediately following the completion of the second or third year of study.

3. Gallant Ho Prizes in Law

One cash prize of HK\$30,000 will be awarded to a graduating LLB student with First-class Honours whom the Undergraduate Assessment Panel considers has achieved the best overall performance in terms of the Major Cumulative Grade Point Average throughout his/her LLB study.

One cash prize of HK\$10,000 will be awarded to a graduating PCLL student whom the PCLL Examination Panel determines has achieved the best overall performance in terms of the Cumulative Grade Point Average throughout his/her PCLL study.

4. Gallant Ho Gold Prize in Law

From 2017-2018, a cash prize of HK\$50,000 will be awarded to a graduating LLB student who has received the Betty Ho Prize in Law in current and the past 3 consecutive years.

The Faculty of Law’s decision in respect of the selection of the prize recipient for the award of the prizes will be final.
