Timothy Loh Prize

Regulations

Timothy Loh LLP (“the Donor”) will kindly donate a scholarship of HK\$15,000 (“the Prize”) to The Chinese University of Hong Kong (“the University”) on an annual basis starting from the academic year 2017/18. Regulations governing the award of the Prize are detailed below:

1. The Prize will be known as the “Timothy Loh Prize”.
2. There will be one (1) award each year.
3. The amount of the Prize will be HK\$15,000.
4. The Prize will be awarded to a Year 1 full-time student or a Year 2 part-time student who enrolled in the Juris Doctor (JD) Programme of the University. Selection of the Prize recipient will be based on the following criteria:
 - i) Outstanding academic merit as shown in the JD Programme.
 - ii) Performance at the interview with the Donor.
 - iii) Other qualities, including demonstrating an interest in finance or other areas of business as shown in prior studies, work experience or other professional qualifications.
5. Each year, on or before January 31, the Dean of the Faculty of Law at the University will nominate suitable candidates based upon academic merit as shown in their studies in the JD Programme. Candidates will be asked to provide their curriculum-vitae and latest transcript for consideration by the Donor.
6. The Donor will invite the nominated candidates for an interview with the Donor around mid-February. Details of the interview will be provided to the candidates by the Donor.
7. In any year when no candidate is considered to have reached a standard worthy of the Prize, no Prize shall be made. The Donor’s decision in respect of the award of the Prize will be final.
