DU Jinsong and LING Zhi Scholarship for Part-time JD Graduates
Regulations

CUHK LAW alumnus, Dr DU Jinsong, together with his wife Ms LING Zhi (“the Donors”) will donate a scholarship of HK\$15,000 (“the Prize”) to The Chinese University of Hong Kong (“the University”) on an annual basis starting from the academic year 2023/24. Regulations governing the award of the Prize are detailed below:

1. The Prize will be known as the “DU Jinsong and LING Zhi Scholarship for Part-time JD Graduates”.
2. Subject to Paragraph 5 below, there will be one (1) award each year.
3. The amount of the Prize will be HK\$15,000.
4. The Prize will be awarded to a Part-time Graduate of the Juris Doctor Programme who achieved the highest Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) among Part-time Graduates in each academic year.
5. In the event that more than one Graduate achieved the same highest CGPA in the Programme, the Prize may be shared and the amount of the Prize divided equally among those Graduates.
6. At the end of each academic year, the Dean of the Faculty of Law will nominate the Prize Recipient(s), and particulars of the nominated Prize Recipient(s) shall be sent to the Donors for confirmation.
7. The Faculty will not be obliged to award the Prize in any year in which it does not consider that the level of achievement of any Graduate in the Programme merits the award.
8. The award will be made for an initial period of five years, and may be continued on a year-by-year basis thereafter. The Donors will give the University not less than twelve months’ notice if the arrangements set out in these Regulations are to be discontinued.
