DeHeng Law Offices (Hong Kong) LLP Prize in Law

Regulations

DeHeng Law Offices and Chungs Lawyers ("the Donor") had agreed to donate an annual prize ("the Prize") to a student enrolled in the Juris Doctor ("JD") or Bachelor of Laws ("LLB") Programmes offered by the Faculty of Law ("the Faculty"), The Chinese University of Hong Kong ("the University") with effect from the academic year 2019-20. The Donor has been renamed "DeHeng Law Offices (Hong Kong) LLP" with effect from March 2023. Regulations governing the Prize are as follows:

- 1. The Prize was originally known as the "DeHeng & Chungs Prize in Law". The Prize name has been changed to "DeHeng Law Offices (Hong Kong) LLP Prize in Law" with effect from 2022/23.
- 2. A sum of HK\$10,000 shall be awarded to a full-time student enrolled in the first year of the JD programme or the third year of the LLB programme at the Faculty.
- 3. Each year, the Dean of the Faculty will nominate suitable candidates for consideration by the Donor based upon the following criteria:
 - Educational qualifications
 - Academic merit
 - Awards and academic distinctions
 - Extra-curricular activities
 - Working experience

Preference will be given to candidates who have not received any other similar awards in the same academic year.

Candidates for the Prize must submit their curriculum vitae, cover letter and latest academic transcript to the Donor via the Faculty.

- 4. The Donor will notify the Faculty the name of the successful candidate for the Prize. The Donor reserves the right to not make the Prize after the selection process in any given year.
- 5. The Faculty will send the name of awardee to the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid ("OAFA") for information and award monies will be disbursed to the awardee via OAFA.
- 6. The Donor shall notify the University prior to the beginning of each academic year if arrangements set out in these Regulations are to be varied or discontinued.
