**Johnson Stokes & Master Scholarship for the LLB Programme**

**Regulations**

Johnson Stokes & Master (“the Firm”) has agreed to donate an annual scholarship (“the Scholarship”) to The Chinese University of Hong Kong (“the University”) with effect from 2017/18 under the following regulations:

1. The Scholarship shall be known as the “Johnson Stokes & Master Scholarship”.
2. The Johnson Stokes & Master Scholarship comprises:
  - a) One monetary award of HK\$50,000 or the tuition of the final year of the LLB Programme (whichever is lower) payable on the selection of the Scholarship recipient.
  - b) The Scholarship recipient shall commit to a two-year training solicitor contract (“the training contract”) with the Firm after graduation from the LLB Programme and the PCLL Programme. Following Scholarship award, the recipient shall join with the paid summer internship at the Firm.
  - c) The training contract includes PCLL tuition reimbursement (upon receipt of satisfactory proof of payment by the Scholarship recipient) and a stipend of HK\$50,000 payable upon commencement of the Scholarship recipient’s PCLL studies.
  - d) If the Scholarship recipient fails to complete the training contract, he/she shall refund the monetary award, the PCLL tuition, and the stipend to the Firm.
3. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a local full-time student in the penultimate year of study for the LLB degree of the University. Selection of the Scholarship recipient will be based on the following criteria:
  - a) Outstanding academic results with a CGPA of 3.6 or above at the time of application for the Scholarship.
  - b) Eligible to work in Hong Kong at the time of application for the Scholarship.
  - c) Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
  - d) Active within the University and the legal community.
4. Each year by October, the Dean of the Faculty of Law of the University will nominate suitable candidates who have met criteria 3 above.
5. Candidates will be invited to apply via the Firm's online recruitment portal and complete the Firm's standard assessments. Candidates shortlisted by the Firm will be invited to attend the selection interview..
6. The Firm’s decision in respect of the selection of the recipient for the award of the Scholarship is final. In any year when there is no suitable candidate, no award shall be made.
7. Confirmation on the renewal of the Scholarship and the amount of the Scholarship for the following academic year will be sought from the Firm in July each year before the start of the academic year.
8. The Firm shall notify the University prior to the beginning of each academic year if arrangements set out in these Regulations are to be varied or discontinued.
