Hogan Lovells Scholarship in Law for JD Students

Regulations

Hogan Lovells (the "Donor") will kindly donate one scholarship to The Chinese University of Hong Kong on an annual basis starting from the academic year 2018-19. Regulations governing the award of the scholarship are detailed below:

- 1. The scholarship will be known as the "Hogan Lovells Scholarship in Law for JD Students" (the "Scholarship").
- 2. There will be one award each year.
- 3. The amount of the Scholarship will be HK\$10,000.
- 4. The Scholarship will be awarded to a full-time or a part-time student studying in the Juris Doctor (JD) Programme of the Faculty of Law within his/her normative study period. Selection for the award of the Scholarship will be primarily based on academic merit. Participation in extra-curricular activities, leadership qualities and personality will also be taken into account.
- 5. Each year in January or February, the Dean of the Faculty of Law will nominate suitable students who are ranked within the top 20 percent in terms of cumulative GPA result of their intake year group to apply for the Scholarship. Nominated students who wish to apply for the Scholarship must complete an online application provided by the Donor by 31 January. Applicants will be invited to attend interviews with the Donor.
- 6. The Scholarship shall be awarded to the successful applicant subject to the successful applicant having accepted a place in the Summer Vacation Scheme offered by the Donor.
- 7. The Donor will notify the Faculty of Law the name of the successful candidate for the Scholarship. Particulars of the candidate will be sent to the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid for information.
- 8. In any year when candidates are judged to be of insufficient merit, no award shall be made. The Donor's decision on the award of the Scholarship will be final.
