# JUDICIAL REVIEW OF ARBITRAL AWARDS

The lecture emphasizes on an empirical study of judicial review of international commercial arbitration by Supreme People's Court (SPC) of China, which is based on 201 replies published by SPC between 2000 and 2012. Empirical data consist of (i) validity of arbitration clauses, (ii) the re-arbitration system which belongs to the setting-aside system of foreign-involved commercial arbitral awards, (iii) recognition and enforcement of international commercial arbitral awards over the past decade and (iv) the characterization and practice of "exceeded award". The Lecture also introduce procedural of recognition and enforcement of arbitral award rendered outside China. It is likely that China's judicial policy toward international commercial arbitral awards will continue to evolve in a positive way.

### About the Speaker:

**Prof. Yi Bo**, *Associate Professor, School of Law, Southeast University*



Yi Bo, Associate Professor from School of Law, Southeast University at Nanjing, Jiangsu Province. His academic research field consists of International Economical Law and Alternative Dispute Settlement. He graduated from SooChow University in Suzhou in June, 2009 and obtained S.J.D degree (subject of International Economical Law).

From November 2007 to June 2008, he acted as a visiting scholar at Cornell Law School, and also acted as a visiting scholar in Worcester Polytechnic Institute through July to August. He is a member of American Society of International Law, the China Law Society, and Jiangsu Provincial Law

Society. He is also secretary of Hong Kong-Macao-Taiwan Law Division of Jiangsu Provincial Law Society. He was accredited with Chinese lawyer license in 2005.
