## MORRISON \& FOERSTER PRIZE FOR JD STUDENTS

## Regulations

Morrison \& Foerster (the "Donor") pledges to set up a prize for students enrolled in the Juris Doctor ("JD") Programme offered by the Faculty of Law (the "Faculty"), The Chinese University of Hong Kong ("CUHK") on an annual basis with effect from academic year 2017-18. The prize will be governed by the following regulations:

1. The prize shall be known as "Morrison \& Foerster Prize for JD Students" (the "Prize").
2. The Prize shall consist of a cash award of HK $\$ 10,000$.
3. Each year, one Prize shall be awarded to a first year or a second year full-time CUHK JD student.
4. Applicants shall submit a curriculum-vitae, a copy of their undergraduate degree transcript and the CUHK JD Programme transcript. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an interview conducted by a selection panel comprising representatives of the Donor and the Faculty. Shortlisted candidates will be required to give a short presentation on a topic provided by the Donor to the selection panel.
5. Selection for the award of the Prize is based on the following criteria:

- The candidate's academic merit as shown in his/her undergraduate degree and the CUHK JD Programme;
- The candidate's performance during the short presentation; and
- The candidate's performance during the selection interview.

6. The Prize shall be awarded subject to the selected candidate having completed a paid summer internship in the Hong Kong office of the Donor in the calendar year in which he/she is selected to receive the Prize.
7. In any year, if the candidates' academic merit or the presentation/interview performance is considered to be of insufficient merit by the selection panel, no Prize will be awarded. The selection panel's decision in respect of the award of the Prize will be final.
